Your return of the 14th Dec. came to hand but I am
 sorry in consequence of which we have required at the Admiralty
 and find the present Statements of the Government are as in the
 above, that the Ship is now at Comantuck, and that its general
 progress she will continue in Jamaica only while the Peace
 force is kept up, which probably may be until April or May
 next, but there seems not the least Idea of her being intended
 for India, and if there was we apprehend you would find no
 difficulty in procuring her Exchange from her into some other
 home Service, however this is more matter of opinion, and
 therefore after having said thus much respecting the Ship you
 had best judge for your self the steps most proper to be pursued.
 As the remove from the Hyana did not happen from your own
 application, we are well assured if you would rather wish
 to remain where you are, you will have only to write Mr
 Stephens to beg he will move their Lordships to Cancel your
 Commis³ for the present, as at the distance you are news
 from her the chance of remove of your things will be so great
 as to make your continuance in the Hyana a matter of
