Having communicated to my Lords
Commissioners of the Admiralty your
Letter of yesterdays date, informing
them of your having joined His
Majesty's Ship the Inconstant, and
requesting for the reason hereimen-
tion'd that you may be allow'd the
Expences you have been at in tra-
-velling from Milford Haven to
join her; I am commanded by their
Lordships to acquaint you that you
cannot have any allowance for
travelling charges, but that an
attention will be had to the keeping
you in employment beyond the
